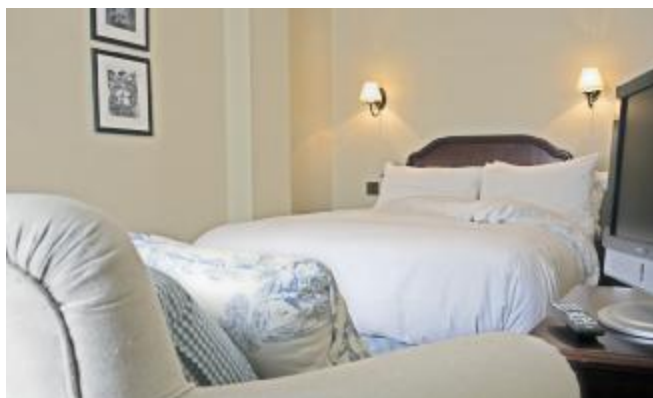

Marriages at The Angel Hotel

The celebration of a marriage usually has several stages, which can be...

- The ceremony
- Photographs
- The drinks and canapés reception and greeting of the guests
- The wedding breakfast
- The evening reception

There is a considerable amount to organise, which we try and explain here. Read through the details, and please contact us for more information. We recommend you check the availability of your preferred date first, with the Registrar (see below) or your place of worship, and then make a provisional booking with us. We will hold the date for 14 days, whilst the other arrangements are made.

The ceremony

You may already be holding the ceremony at your place of worship (for information about a reception go to page four). But if you wish, you may hold the entire event at The Angel Hotel.

The Angel Hotel is licensed to conduct civil marriage ceremonies and partnerships in its three function rooms. The Brecon Suite is ideal for smaller parties up to 40, the Wedgewood Room can accommodate up to 80, and for up to 180, the grand Ballroom is appropriate. Note, our licence does not permit ceremonies to take place in any other part of the hotel.

Before discussing dates with the hotel, the couple should contact the Monmouth District Register Office to engage the services of a Registrar to conduct the ceremony. Once you have a date from the Registrar, come and see us. Then you will have to confirm your reservation at The Angel Hotel with a £500.00 deposit.

The ceremony at the hotel

According to regulations, food and drink are not permitted in the ceremony room prior to the wedding. The civil ceremony usually lasts approximately 20 to 30 minutes, depending upon your requirements. We will happily assist with providing a harpist or a pianist at an additional charge. Please note that any music or readings you may wish to include within the ceremony must be secular (non-religious), and agreed in advance with the Registrar who will be attending the ceremony.

Note that we only host civil ceremonies for clients who have arranged their wedding breakfast at the hotel to follow the ceremony.

Photographs and the drinks reception

Following the ceremony, we recommend photographs be taken at Abergavenny Castle, only a few hundred yards from the hotel. The Castle grounds with the backdrop of the Blorenge mountain make a spectacular setting.

We will be happy to organise a drinks and canapés reception in either the Castle grounds, while your photographs are being taken, or afterwards in the hotel. This is an elegant way to start off the celebration.

We propose welcoming apéritifs, flutes of sparkling wine served on silver trays, with fresh orange juice as an alternative. Should you wish, hotel staff can offer your guests trays of canapés. See the canapés selection on the next page.

The wedding breakfast

For most this is the centrepiece of the celebration and it's important to get it right. Our experience tells us what works. From the range of dishes overleaf, we offer menus of three courses, plus coffee or tea to follow, with petits fours.

You must select a menu where all the guests have the same dishes. This will let food service run smoothly. There will probably be a few guests who are vegetarian or have other food constraints, who we can happily cater for.

We ask that you choose one starter, one main course and one dessert, meaning all of your guests attending the wedding breakfast will have the same meal, with the exception of those with special dietary needs.

We lay the tables with plain white table linen, simple, stylish glassware, white china, small white floral arrangements and tea light candles. The layout of the room depends on the numbers attending and will be discussed with the bride and groom.

The menu price is determined by your choice of main course. These are in four bands, per person, fully inclusive of room hire.

A,B,C: £39.00 D,E,F: £45.00 G,H: £49.00

Please note, children aged 12 and under are charged at half-price. We can provide simpler menu options for children if required. Since you may be booking several months or more than a year in advance, we reserve the right to increase the price of your wedding quoted, by no more than 5% per annum, if necessary.

The evening reception

Following an afternoon ceremony and wedding breakfast, many of our wedding clients like to continue the celebrations with a reception in the evening. This also gives an opportunity to extend the guest list beyond the numbers for the wedding breakfast. If you have held your wedding breakfast with us, and you arrange for a buffet to be served during the evening for a minimum number of 80% of the guest total, we are pleased to provide one of our function rooms with our compliments. You may provide drinks for your guests or they can purchase their own. Note that if you use the Ballroom, the terrace must be vacated by 11.00pm, due to local noise restrictions.

The hotel will provide small white floral arrangements for each table during the wedding breakfast as part of your package. After the wedding breakfast, a member of staff will move the flowers if necessary for the evening reception. If additional flowers are required, for example in the ceremony room or for the evening reception, our florist can organise these. Indicative costs are...

On request we will provide a 13½" square stand for the wedding cake, and a knife, free of charge.

We suggest the cutting of the cake is done after dessert has been served. The cake can either be served on the buffet table for the evening reception, or the hotel will store it in a cool place to be collected on departure from the hotel.

Parking and accommodation

We offer some parking spaces at the rear of the hotel. And there is a large public car park right behind our own car park.

The hotel has 32 guestrooms, on the first and second floors, including our bridal suite with a four-poster bed, and some refurbished rooms. Plus we have The Lodge in the grounds of Abergavenny Castle, adjacent to the hotel, consisting of a sitting room, breakfast room, kitchen, patio area, ensuite facilities and two double-bedded rooms on the first floor. Hotel guestrooms have television, telephone, tea and coffee making facilities, hair-dryer, and Gilchrist and Soames toiletries. The hotel also offers complimentary overnight shoeshine, and a complimentary pass to nearby KeepersFit Gym.

Subject to minimum overall spend of £4,500 (excluding accommodation), we offer the bridal couple our bridal suite with our compliments on the wedding night.

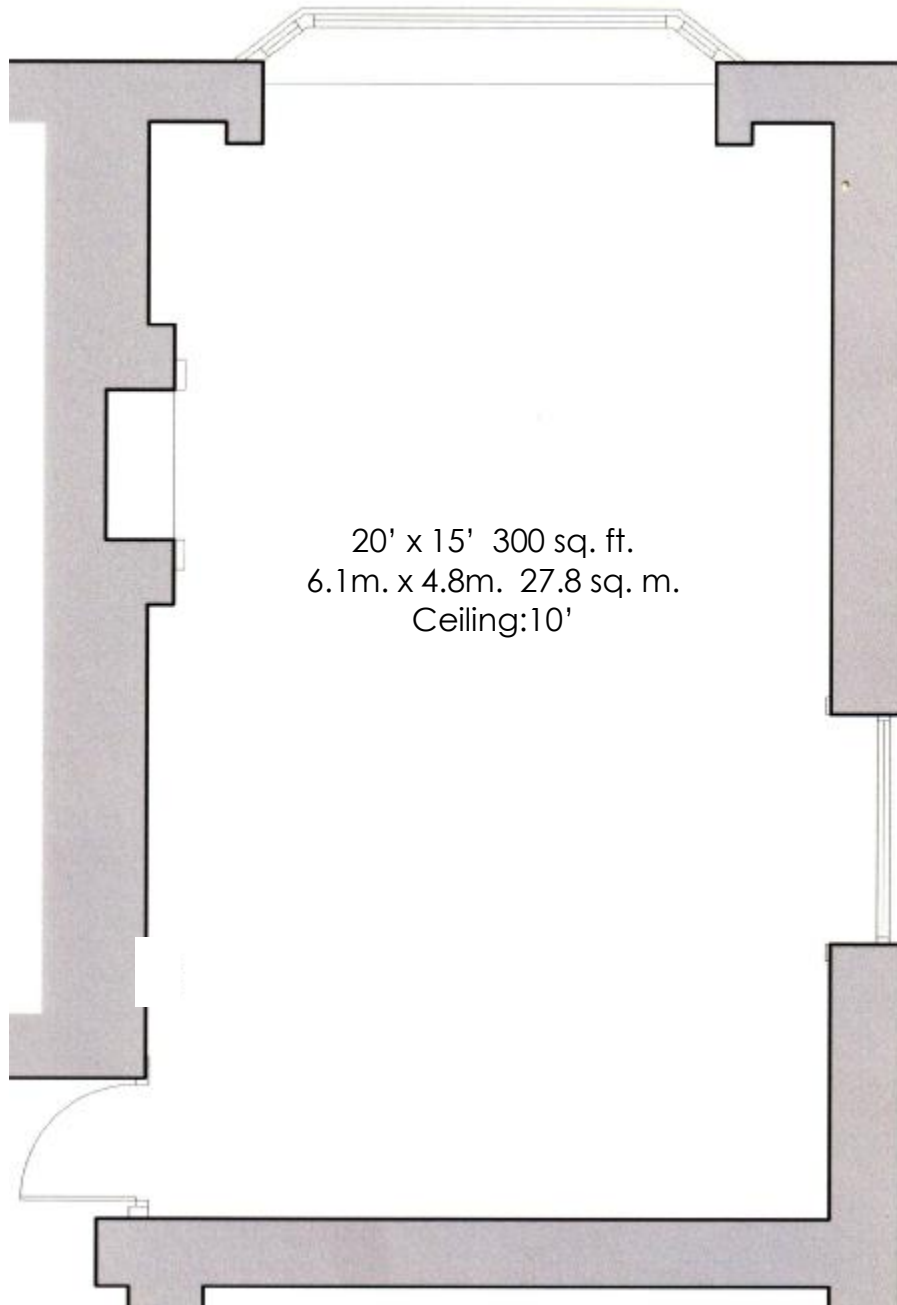

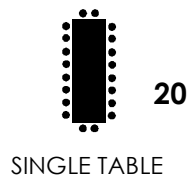
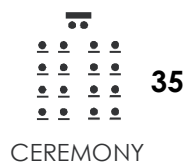
Check in time is 3.00pm, and check out time is 11.00am. Whilst we cannot make guarantees, we will try to make rooms available earlier in the day, if required.

The Brecon Suite

The Brecon Suite is a recently re-furbished room, on the first floor overlooking the town. It has plenty of natural light, supplemented by dimmable halogen lighting and is air-conditioned. It is suited well for wedding ceremonies (max. 40), smaller wedding breakfasts around one large oval table (max. 20). Or for a reception or buffet (max. 40).

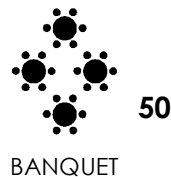
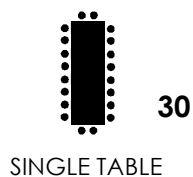
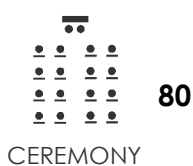
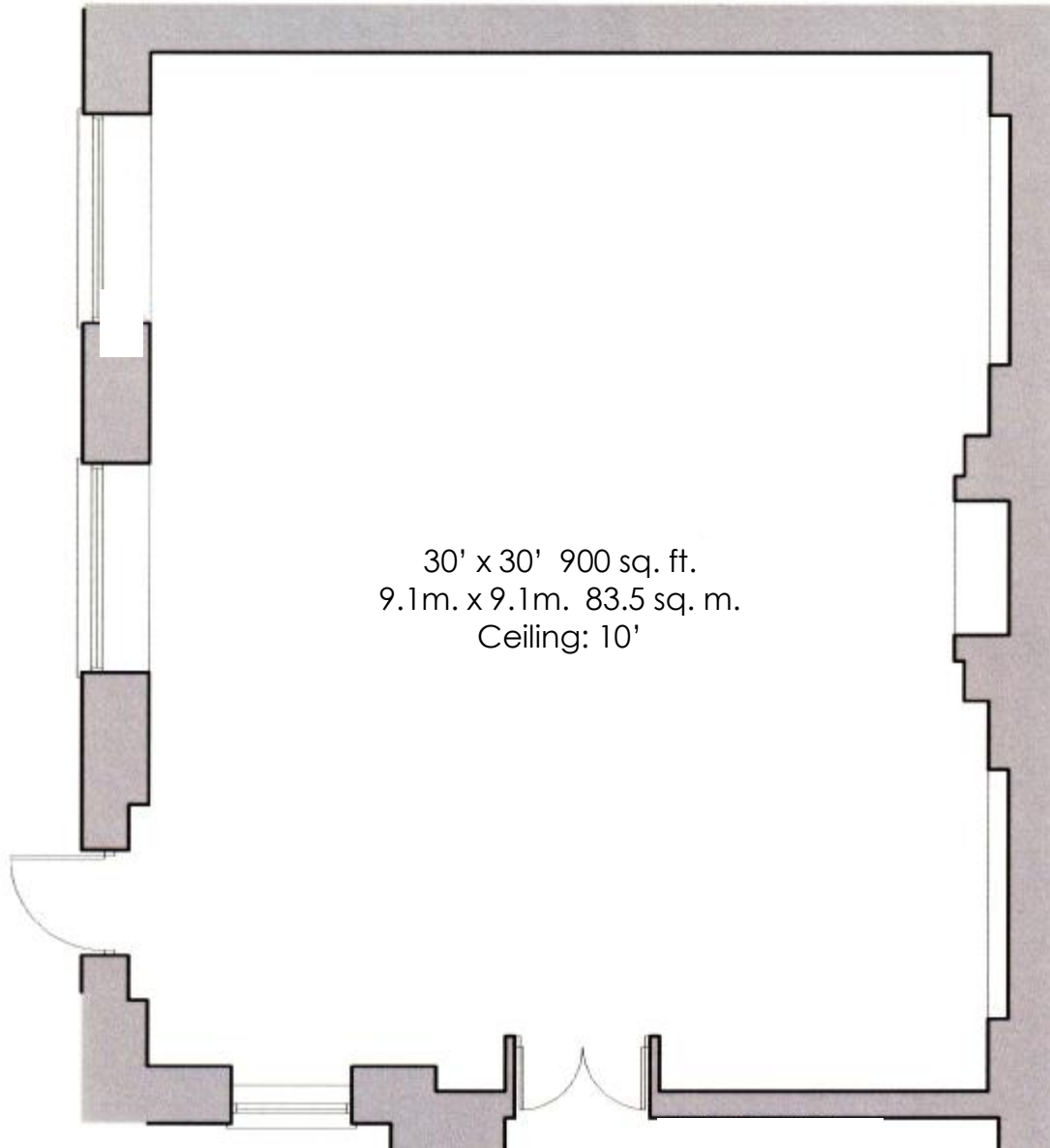

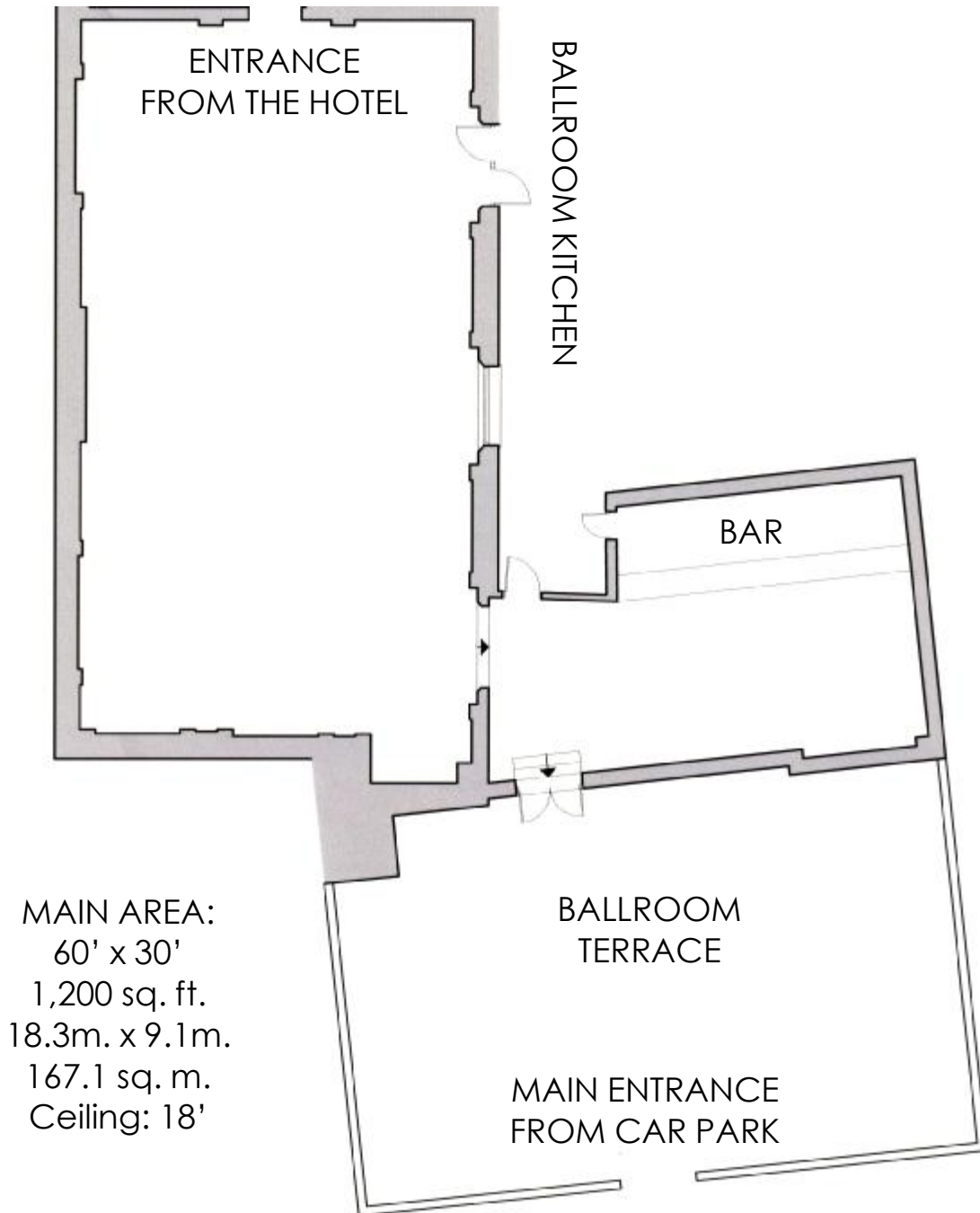
The Wedgewood Room

The Wedgewood Room is on the ground floor with easy access from the car park. It is recently re-furnished, with air-conditioning. It has natural light, but is mainly lit by a controllable Halogen system. As well as being ideal for medium-size ceremonies and wedding breakfasts, it is useful for larger functions, where the drinks reception can be held in the Wedgewood Room, and then guests proceed upstairs to the Ballroom for the wedding breakfast. Capacity depends on layout; see below.




The Ballroom

The spacious first floor Ballroom has its own entrance from the car park. It has its own bar and terrace, and is suitable for large wedding breakfasts and receptions. Maximum numbers are shown below. Note too, the terrace area cannot be used after 11.00pm due to local noise restrictions.

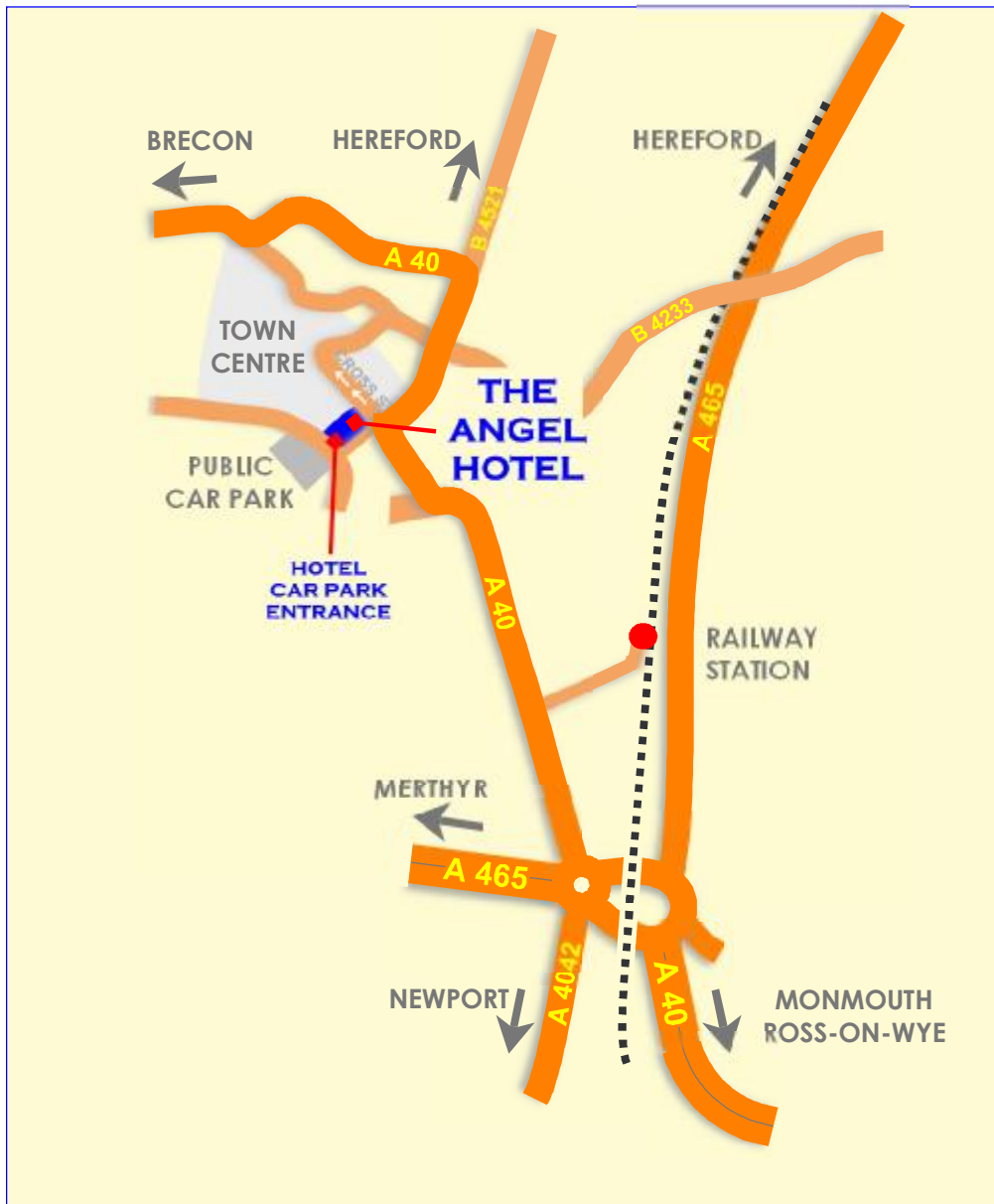

Location



Abergavenny sits on the South-East edge of the Brecon Beacons. By train there is a mainline railway station, just south of the town, coming from London and Cardiff via Newport, and the North via Hereford. It's a ten minute walk. But with luggage, book a taxi to collect you. We recommend the reliable... Sheila's Taxis, 01873 857954.

There is an excellent network of roads to Abergavenny. You get here from the Midlands via Ross-on-Wye on the M50, or from London and the East, via the Severn bridges, on the M4. Leave the M4 at junction 24, and go North on the A449 up to Raglan, and then West on the A40 to Abergavenny.

You'll approach Abergavenny on the A4042 from the South, the A465 from the West and North, or the A40 from the East. These roads meet at a roundabout just south of the town. Take the A40 signposted to Abergavenny. Soon after the start of the shops the traffic can turn sharp left or right. Turn left into a narrow road immediately alongside The Angel Hotel. The hotel car park is the next turning on your right. If it is full, you may drop off your passengers and park in the public car park opposite.

Wedding Terms and Conditions

'The Hotel' refers to The Angel Hotel, Abergavenny. 'The client' refers to the person who makes the wedding booking, also referred to as 'the event'. The Angel Hotel terms and conditions apply from when signed confirmation of the wedding arrangements is received by the Hotel. Any changes to these terms must be confirmed in writing by the Hotel. In signing the initial reservation form and paying a deposit, the client accepts that the following terms and conditions are applicable.

Provisional Bookings and Deposits

A provisional booking will be held for up to 14 days. A signed reservation letter from the client, plus a £500.00 non-refundable deposit will confirm the reservation. In addition, the hotel requires a second non-refundable deposit of £1,000 six months ahead of the event. If the booking is made less than six months ahead, £1,500 is required as an initial non-refundable deposit.

Payment

The full payment (less the £1,500 deposits) is due to the Hotel one month prior to your event. Six weeks prior to the event the Hotel will supply the client with a statement of costs and invoice. This will itemise the details of the initial quote (subject to any later agreed changes), but the Hotel reserves the right to raise overall prices by up to 5% per annum from the time of booking. This is to cover inflation and increased expenses. Should VAT, alcohol duty or any other relevant tax also have changed, this will be reflected in the final invoice.

The client is responsible for the checking and settlement of the account. Any further charges incurred, are due the morning after the wedding day unless the Hotel has agreed alternative arrangements. Should the Hotel not receive full payment within 28 days of the wedding reception date, the Hotel reserves the right to re-negotiate the event, which may result in cancellation. Payment may be made by cash, cheque, and bankers draft, debit card, Visa, MasterCard or American Express.

Outstanding amounts owed by the client are expected to be paid immediately following the event, before departure from the hotel. If the client has an outstanding balance after 7 days, the Hotel reserves the right to make a late payment charge of 5%.

Overall Pricing

If there is a significant alteration in the agreed food and drinks arrangements and/or a substantial reduction in attendance figures, the Hotel reserves the right to modify both the package prices and the venue rental fees. The Hotel also reserves the right to change an original quoted price for foods and alcoholic beverages if prices from our suppliers significantly change.

Cancellation by the Client

Should the client have to cancel the booking a charge will be made to alleviate possible financial loss to the Hotel. Wedding arrangements are usually made well in advance. Therefore we must make cancellation charges. Note that any specific costs already incurred from our suppliers for a particular event will be charged in full. For the arrangements in general, if the client chooses to cancel, the following charges will apply:

Cancellation: less than 8 weeks	100%
Cancellation: 8 weeks to 6 months	75%
Cancellation: 6 months to 12 months	50%
Cancellation: over 12 months	£500 deposit

Separate charges will apply for cancellation of guest room accommodation.

Cancellation by the Hotel

The Hotel may cancel the booking:

- a) If the Hotel or a significant part of it is closed due to fire, dispute with employees, or by order of any public authority.
- b) If the client does not settle the final account 28 days ahead of the event.
- c) If the client is more than 30 days in arrears with payment to the Hotel for other previously supplied services.
- d) If matters arise where the Hotel is of the opinion that hosting the event would damage the Hotel's reputation.

If the Hotel has to cancel, all advance payments will be refunded, but the Hotel assumes no further liability to the client.

Numbers

Provisional numbers will be asked for at the time of the original booking and the Hotel reserves the right to set a minimum number to be charged for the event. Should actual attendance exceed the number on the final invoice, the client will be charged for that number of guests in attendance. If actual numbers are less than on the final invoice, you will be charged for that number unless the reduced numbers are agreed to by the Hotel Manager at least 7 days in advance.

Guestroom Accommodation

A block number of guestrooms may be reserved by the client for guests. The client will be alerted 21 days in advance of any guestrooms not confirmed by their guests. The client then has the choice to keep or release the remaining guestrooms. If there are remaining guestrooms that are not cancelled within 14 days of the event, the client will incur the full charges for all unconfirmed guestroom accommodation.

Wedding Terms and Conditions

Damage and Behaviour of Clients and Guests
